WRSOS maintains a province wide hotline - 12 hours a day, 365 days a year. It is here that people can call for help or information regarding wildlife issues. A dramatic increase in calls from 177 in our first year to almost 2000 in 2014 demonstrates a real need for our organization and the service we provide.
