ABOUT WRSOS

The Wildlife Rehabilitation Society of Saskatchewan (WRSOS) is a volunteer driven, registered non-profit organization. In 2006 WRSOS was formed to address a need in the province of Saskatchewan. There were businesses and organizations that dealt with pest control, domestic and exotic animals, livestock and wildlife crimes but, no avenue for people to help injured and orphaned wildlife. This left the general public to fend for themselves potentially exposing both people and wildlife to injury, zoonotic diseases and sometimes leaving wildlife incapacitated by improper nutrition, care or habituation to humans.

This gap was filled by the formation of Canada's only provincial wildlife hotline and rescue service in 2007. The hotline operates 12 hours per day, 365 days per year and is currently receiving well over 3000 calls per year. With our network of approximately 130 volunteers and several partner organizations we offer expert advice, and coordinate rescues, transportation and placement of injured and orphaned wildlife within qualified, licensed facilities.

WRSOS has collaborated with Environment officers, the Ministry of the Environment, wildlife veterinarians, and experienced wildlife rehabilitators from other regions of North America to help develop organization protocols and to ensure regulations and standards have been put in place to better assist both the public and wildlife.

WRSOS is dedicated to protecting Saskatchewan wildlife. WRSOS aims to promote education, respect, understanding, and appreciation of wildlife and the environment so that humans and wildlife can successfully coexist.

Gone Wild for Wildlife is the WRSOS' premier wildlife educational event in Saskatchewan; it also serves as a critical fundraising and awareness event to support the organizations efforts.
